To all registered members

If you have played in this competition before most of this will be familiar to you. If this is your first season with us here is some information we ask you and your club to follow and we hope you will find of interest and guidance. This information is mainly for your benefit. Your club Secretary has a league handbook with more detail and all communication between the league and clubs is dealt with through them. They are also sent a monthly messenger with fixtures and other information. Please use them as much as possible. Our objective is to make the season as enjoyable as possible for all concerned in playing, refereeing and administering this competition.

Guidelines

- 1 .You can only be registered for one club playing in this competition. You must obtain a transfer if you wish to become a member of another club even if they are in another division. Your club Secretary has the necessary transfer forms. You can of course register for other clubs playing in different competitions (e.g. Saturdays, Sundays or Midweek). If you sign for two clubs in this competition without a transfer your registration will be automatically cancelled pending an enquiry.
- 2 .Your club is affiliated to the Kent County Football Association Limited under whose jurisdiction you come.
3. Your club is held responsible for the behaviour of its' members and supporters. Clubs have been heavily fined in the past for their so called "supporters" unruly behaviour.
- 4 .Each caution offence incurs a minimum administration charge and each sending off offence incurs a fine and suspension. These fines are collected by the KCFA. Five cautions in one season also incurs a suspension. The KCFA handbook contains more details about these punishments. Please find out about them, the less offences we have to deal with the more people will be playing on a Sunday and the more enjoyable it will be for all concerned. If you are sent off twice in one season you are liable to have your registration cancelled.
5. Your Club has mandatory insurance through the KCFA Ltd for personal injury.
6. The League has its own Benevolent Fund, applications available if you are suffering financial hardship through injury in this competition.
- 7 .Every club must have an adequate first aid box. Any player with a medical problem that may manifest itself during play should inform the manager of any action required.
- 8 .Should your club withdraw from this competition you will be held responsible, proportionately, for any debts owing to this league. When signing a registration form you automatically agree to this as a member of the club. You are not just registering as a player.
9. There are many referees officiating, some of them ex players. Please make them feel welcome. They have an unenviable task and have to make split second decisions, please accept their decisions first time whether you agree or not! Nobody is perfect, not even a referee, remember the referee is in charge from the moment he walks on to the pitch to the time he leaves the ground. As many matches are played on public parks your conduct is representative of this League. Adverse reports from the public are taken very seriously.

Do have an enjoyable season, the Management Committee wish you and your Club every success.

Sportsmanship Award- Every season the referees and the clubs in your division vote for the team they consider to be the most sporting. Divisional and overall prizes for this award are presented at the AGM. It may be worth remembering this during your season!
